\*Students who attend community colleges that do not offer ARTH 2010 and/or ARTH 2020 will complete these courses upon transfer to Watkins. These students will instead complete requirements in the humanities/Fine Arts as prescribed at the community college where they are enrolled. In this case, the Humanities/Fine Arts classes will transfer to Watkins as electives. ART 1030 Art Appreciation does not transfer to Watkins and should not be taken at the community college to meet Humanities/Fine Arts requirements.

\*\*Watkins has a first year Core program that consists of 6 credits each for the fall and spring semesters. ART 1010, ARTP 1110, ARTP 1120, and the studio elective will transfer as COR 101 and COR 102 *IF* the AA studio elective is a time-based media course. In the event that a time-based course is not taken as the AA studio elective, ARTP 1010 and ARTP 1120 will be transferred in as COR 101. ARTP 1110 will be applied toward COR 102 after the student successfully completes a time-based media class at Watkins. The studio elective will be applied as a Studio Elective or required course in the program plan of study.

\*\*\*This plan of study allows for six (6) credit hours general education electives. These credit hours cannot be used to satisfy degree requirements in this Plan of Study.
